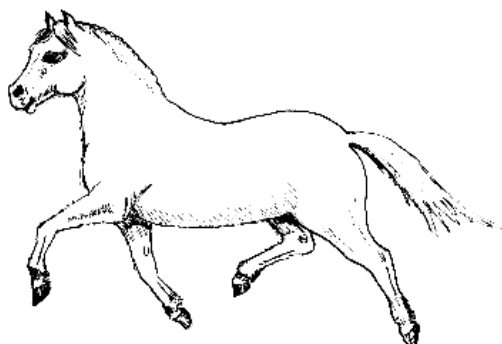

Qualification for Summer National Championships

1st, 2nd and 3rd placed horses/ponies in all Summer National Championships will qualify for the 2012 P(UK) Summer National Championships

Results must be submitted to the Ponies (UK) offices within 14 days of the qualifying show with the exception of shows being held between 1st July and 31st July need to submit their results within 48hrs after the qualifying event. Qualification cards will not be presented in the ring. Competitors in qualifying positions, who are **not** current members of P(UK) are allowed **14 days** in which to become members and register their horse/ponies in order for the qualification to remain valid. The exception being any competitor qualifying at a show between 5th July and 26th July must submit their membership within 48 hrs after the qualifying event in order for the qualification to remain valid.

P(UK) Glyn Greenwood M & M In Hand Championship Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies of all ages, registered with the respective pure breed societies of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A,B,C & D. Stallions, Colts, Fillies, Mares or Geldings. Classes 1-12, 17-40, 57-68 & 87-94 1st, 2nd & 3rd in all classes will qualify

EQUIFEST CHAMPIONSHIPS Two highest placed exhibits in the following classes, and not already qualified, will qualify for the relevant Equifest Championship to be held at the East of England Showground on the 19th – 22nd August 2012 Classes: 1-11, 15 & 16, 17-27, 29-39, 56, 57-67, 78 - 80, 82 – 84, 87, 94, 96 - 98, 99 - 101 and 107 & 108

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breeds are not eligible.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non member but only ponies owned by adult Full, Life or Standard NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 1st - 3rd August 2012. The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line, which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified, receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3rd place. Judges and/or stewards will check membership cards prior to presenting the qualifying rosettes and cards. NPS Standard members will be required to upgrade to Full membership to enter the final.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes can only be won by ponies owned by Full, Life or Standard members of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships. Winners of WHP, LR & FR classes are not eligible for the Ridden Silver Medal Championship

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

THE NATIONAL WELSH CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW 2012 – Finals will be held on Sunday 12th August at the 3 Counties Showground, Malvern, Worcs. The National Brightwells In-hand, Bedlay Stud Ridden Wp-Br and Brynseion Ridden qualifiers are eligible to compete at this event. Streatlam Farm is situated on the A688 between Barnard Castle & Staindrop, near the village of Stainton. The Showfield is 1 mile east of Barnard Castle, on the left hand side, coming from the town, and is easily accessible from the A1, A66 & M6

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All animals to be registered in the appropriate studbook. All registration numbers must be stated on the entry form.
2. The committee reserve the right to refuse any entry
3. The committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any class/classes
4. On no account is any animal to be exhibited under a judge who is known to have bred, leased, sold or produced that animal
5. All Colts and Stallions over 2 years old must correctly bitted with a snaffle type bridle and led by a handler who has attained their 14th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year. They must be licensed as per their appropriate breed society.
6. All trophies remain the property of the NECWPCA and winners are responsible for their safe return
7. The judges decision is FINAL
8. Anyone conducting themselves in a disorderly manner will be asked to leave the Showground
9. Exhibitors must ensure all animals are sound. If in the opinion of the judge, any animal is considered unsound, the exhibitor may withdraw the exhibit from the class or ask for a vet to examine the animal. If no vet is available, the judge's decision is final. (All vet's fees paid by exhibitor)
10. Objections must be lodged in writing to the Secretary within thirty minutes of the disputed event. A deposit of £30 must be paid, which will be returned if the objection is upheld. The decision of the committee is FINAL
11. In the event of any dispute relating to the Association, the committee shall form a quorum of not less than five committee members in order to deal with that dispute. Their decision being final and binding without any appeal to law
12. It is recommended that all exhibitors have PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE
13. All foals must be three weeks old or over on the day of the show
14. Correctly secured skull caps/riding hats to the approved BSI standard should be worn by riders at all times when mounted and by children whilst in the ring
15. **Policy for closing rings:**
IN HAND – When the last pony/cob has done its individual trot round.
RIDDEN - When the class goes into trot
16. Exhibitors are reminded that all times are approximate, please have all exhibits forward in good time. Where an animal is entered in more than one class, the committee accepts no responsibility should they clash
17. The Association, committee, assistants or stewards shall in no way be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury, howsoever caused
18. Any animal thought to be suffering from any infectious or contagious disease will be asked to leave the showground immediately by the committee
19. All ridden ponies must be four years old & over
20. Ridden Stallions - Sections A & B to be ridden by children 12 years old & over. Sections C & D to be ridden by children 14 years old & over
21. No entry fee will be refunded unless a Veterinary Certificate is produced
22. Dogs must be kept on the lead at all times
23. All exhibitors must be conversant with the current rules set by the WPCS, P(UK), NPS & NECWPCA

PLEASE NOTE THE CHANGES TO THE LAYOUT OF THE SHOWFIELD. THESE HAVE BEEN IMPLEMENTED TO IMPROVE THE HEALTH AND SAFETY ASPECT OF OUR SHOW AT STREATLAM FARM.

THE MAIN CHANGE IS THAT WE HAVE BROUGHT THE TWO COB SECTIONS DOWN TO THE LOWER RING, NEAREST THE ENTRANCE, AND MOVED THE RIDDEN CLASSES UP TO THE TOP OF THE SHOWFIELD. OUR RIDDEN COMPETITORS, AND THE CLASSES WE RUN FOR THEM, HAVE INCREASED SUBSTANTIALLY OVER THE YEARS AND WE HAVE THEREFORE MADE THE DECISION TO ALLOCATE TWO RINGS TO RUN AT THE SAME TIME. WE HAVE TRIED TO WORK THE TIMETABLE IN SUCH A WAY THAT COMPETITORS WHO ENTER CLASSES IN BOTH RINGS WILL NOT MISS ANY, BUT CANNOT GUARANTEE THAT THEY WILL NOT CLASH. IT VERY MUCH DEPENDS ON THE NUMBERS IN EACH CLASS. THERE IS ALSO A WORKING IN AREA BEHIND THE TWO RINGS. WE SUGGEST THAT ALL RIDDEN COMPETITORS PARK THEIR WAGGONS AT THE TOP SO THAT THEY WILL HAVE EASY ACCESS TO THEIR RINGS.

IT WOULD ALSO MAKE SENSE FOR THE COB COMPETITORS TO USE THE HARD STANDING NEAREST THE MAIN GATE, AND ADJACENT TO THEIR OWN RING.

THE TWO PONY RINGS WILL HAVE A COLLECTING AREA AT THE TOP OF THE TWO RINGS, THUS AVOIDING THE WORST OF THE HILL WHEN RUNNING THEIR PONIES!

SPECIFIC SPECTATOR ONLY AREAS HAVE BEEN CREATED, WHICH WILL PROVIDE GOOD VANTAGE POINTS TO VIEW ALL THE RINGS WITH SAFETY.

THERE ARE ALSO DESIGNATED WALKWAYS TO ALLOW ONLY THOSE PONIES/COBS COMPETING IN THEIR RESPECTIVE RINGS TO ACCESS. THIS WILL EFFECTIVELY SEPARATE ALL RIDDEN COMPETITORS FROM THOSE WITH IN HAND PONIES ETC. WHICH HAS BEEN THE SCOURCE OF PROBLEMS IN THE PAST.

WE HOPE YOU WILL ALL APPRECIATE THE NECESSITY OF THESE CHANGES AND BEAR WITH THE COMMITTEE AS WE STRIVE TO IMPROVE CONDITIONS FOR ALL OUR COMPETITORS AND SPECTATORS ALIKE.
