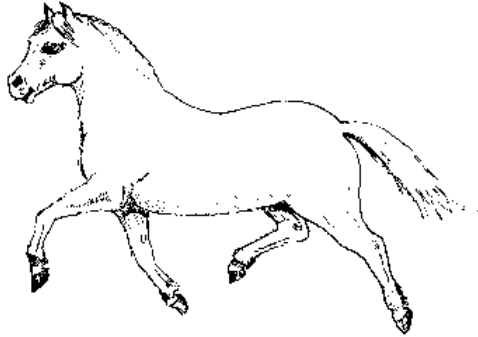

SHETLANDS

All ponies must be Registered with the Shetland Society and full details completed on the entry form. Society rosettes will only be given to ponies registered with the Shetland Society or eligible for registration (ie foals) Three year old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the Show. Children under 14 yrs old may not show colts (excluding foals) or entire males in In-hand classes. Children under 11 yrs old on the day of the show may not show entire males in ridden classes. In the interests of safety, hard hats must be worn by all handlers aged 14 yrs or under in In-hand classes. Hard hats must be worn by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes. In ridden Classes, if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.

Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

or more in any open Ridden Mountain & Moorland class at any show on or before 1st January in the current year. Rider any age.

CLASS 107 Open to Confined Novice Mountain & Moorland Ponies registered with their respective pure breed society stud books of Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, New Forrest and Welsh Sections C or D. Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over not to have won a first prize of £10.00 or more in any open Ridden Mountain & Moorland class at any show on or before 1st January in the current year. Rider any age.

OPEN M&M RIDDEN PONY

CLASS 108 Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective pure breed society of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland Welsh A & B. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age (Please note rule 19)

CLASS 109 Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective pure breed society of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C & D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age (Please note rule 19)

CHERIF CHAMPIONSHIP – Open to all Anglo & Part Bred Arab stallions, mares & geldings 4years old & over. *All exhibitors are issued with colour coded qualifying cards, which state the height section of the horse/pony. Competitors must carry their qualifying cards with them in the ring to be signed by the judge. Failure to produce the card for signature means non qualification. NO CARDS ARE TO BE BROUGHT INTO THE RING ONCE THE CLASS HAS STARTED.*

CLASS 110 148cms & Under – To qualify: One Blue Card: Will not be ridden by the judge at qualifying shows, but will be ridden by a lightweight adult at the Cherif Championship final.

One entry will qualify. The highest placed entry within the first four in the class, who has not already qualified, will qualify.

CLASS 111 Over 148cms – To qualify: One White Card and one Green Card. Will be ridden by the judge.

Two may qualify. The highest placed entries within the first four in the class at (a) up to and including 153cms (15.25hh) and (b) over 153cms will qualify. No entry placed lower than fourth can qualify, even if only one height section is covered by the top four in the class.

Mini Champion & Reserve together with 1st and 2nd prizewinners from classes 104 – 109 to go forward for the M&M Ridden Championship. Champion & Reserve to then go forward, together with the Welsh Ridden Champion and Reserve, Class 72 Welsh Part Bred 1st placed winner and 1st placed winners from Classes 110 & 111, for the Supreme Ridden Championship Sash

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. *All animals to be registered in the appropriate studbook. All registration numbers must be stated on the entry form.*
2. *The committee reserve the right to refuse any entry*
3. *The committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any class/classes*
4. *On no account is any animal to be exhibited under a judge who is known to have bred, leased, sold or produced that animal*
5. *All Colts and Stallions over 2 years old must be licensed with the appropriate breed society, correctly bitted with a snaffle type bridle and led by a handler who has attained their 14th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year*
6. *All trophies remain the property of the NECWPCA and winners are responsible for their safe return*
7. *The judges decision is FINAL*
8. *Anyone conducting themselves in a disorderly manner will be asked to leave the Showground*
9. *Exhibitors must ensure all animals are sound. If in the opinion of the judge, any animal is considered unsound, the exhibitor may withdraw the exhibit from the class or ask for a vet to examine the animal. If no vet is available, the judge's decision is final. (All vet's fees paid by exhibitor)*
10. *Objections must be lodged in writing to the Secretary within thirty minutes of the disputed event. A deposit of £30 must be paid, which will be returned if the objection is upheld. The decision of the committee is FINAL*
11. *In the event of any dispute relating to the Association, the committee shall form a quorum of not less than five committee members in order to deal with that dispute. Their decision being final and binding without any appeal to law*
12. *It is recommended that all exhibitors have PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE*
13. *All foals must be three weeks old or over on the day of the show*
14. *Correctly secured skull caps/riding hats to the approved BSI standard should be worn by riders at all times when mounted and by children whilst in the ring*
15. Policy for closing rings:
IN HAND – When the last pony/cob has done its individual trot round.
RIDDEN - When the class goes into trot
16. *Exhibitors are reminded that all times are approximate, please have all exhibits forward in good time. Where an animal is entered in more than one class, the committee accepts no responsibility should they clash*
17. *The Association, committee, assistants or stewards shall in no way be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury, howsoever caused*
18. *Any animal thought to be suffering from any infectious or contagious disease will be asked to leave the showground immediately by the committee*
19. *All ridden ponies must be four years old & over*
20. *Ridden Stallions - Sections A & B to be ridden by children 12 years old & over.
Sections C & D to be ridden by children 14 years old & over*
21. *No entry fee will be refunded unless a Veterinary Certificate is produced*
22. *Dogs must be kept on the lead at all times*
23. *All exhibitors must be conversant with the current rules set by the WPCS, & NECWPCA*
