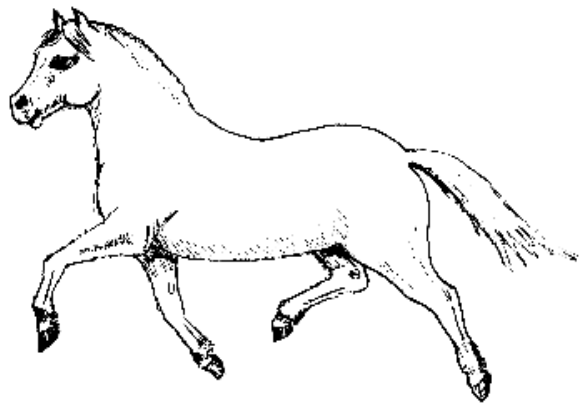

Qualification for Summer National Championships

1st, 2nd and 3rd placed horses/ponies in all qualifying classes will qualify for the 2012 P(UK) Summer National Championships

Results must be submitted to the Ponies (UK) offices within 14 days of the qualifying show with the exception of shows being held between 5th July and 26th July need to submit their results within 48hrs after the qualifying event.

Qualification cards will not be presented in the ring. Placings will be confirmed by results sent in by the show secretary.

Competitors in qualifying positions, who are **not** current members of P(UK) are allowed **14 days** in which to become members and register their horse/ponies in order for the qualification to remain valid. The exception being any competitor qualifying at a show between 5th July and 26th July must submit their membership within 48 hrs after the qualifying event in order for the qualification to remain valid.

P(UK) Glyn Greenwood Memorial M & M In Hand Championship Classes 1 – 7, 19-25, 26-32, 35-39, 46 – 49 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class will qualify.

This Show is affiliated to EQUIFEST, taking place at the East of England Showground on the 16th – 19th August 2012. The **two** highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify. CLASSES 1 – 7, 8-11, 19-25, 26-32, 35-41, 44 & 45, 46-49, 51, 53, 54, 71 & 72 APPLY

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and nonmember but only ponies owned by adult NPS Full Standard or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 1st -3rd August 2012. The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3rd place. Judges and/or stewards will check membership cards prior to presenting the qualifying rosettes and cards. NPS Standard members will be required to upgrade to Full membership to enter the final.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Full, Standard or Life member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships. Winners of WHP, LR & FR classes are not eligible for the Ridden Silver Medal Championship

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

FROM THE SOUTH:

On the A1 heading north take the A6136 for Catterick & Richmond. At the top of the slip road there is a brown tourist sign RICHMOND EQUESTRIAN CENTRE 2 ¼ miles. Follow subsequent signs as directed.

FROM THE NORTH:

On the A1 heading south take the first turn off past Scotch Corner (A6136) signposted Catterick. Continue on this road past Catterick race course and into Catterick Village. In the village turn right where there is a brown tourist sign RICHMOND EQUESTRIAN CENTRE, follow subsequent signs as directed.

Rules & Regulations

1. All animals to be registered in their appropriate studbook. All registration numbers must be stated on the entry form.
2. The committee reserve the right to refuse any entry.
3. The committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any class(es).
4. On no account is any animal to be exhibited under a judge who is known to have bred, leased, sold or produced that animal.
5. All Colts and Stallions over 2 years old must be correctly bitted with a snaffle type bridle and led by a handler who has attained their 14th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year. They must be licensed as per their appropriate breed society.
6. All trophies remain the property of the NECWPCA and winners are responsible for their safe return.
7. The judges decision is FINAL
8. Anyone conducting themselves in a disorderly manner will be asked to leave the Showground.
9. Exhibitors must ensure all animals are sound. If in the opinion of the judge any animal is considered unsound, the exhibitor may withdraw the exhibit from the class or ask for a vet to examine the animal, if no vet is available the judge's decision is final. (all vets fees paid by exhibitor)
10. Objections must be lodged in writing to the Secretary within thirty minutes of the disputed event. A deposit of £30 must be paid, which will be returned if the objection is upheld. The decision of the committee is FINAL.
11. The committee will deal with all disputes relating to the Association and their decision is final and binding without any appeal to law.
12. It is recommended that all exhibitors have PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE.
13. Correctly secured skull caps / riding hats to be worn by riders at all times when mounted and by children whilst in the ring.
14. Exhibitors are reminded that all times are approximated, please have all exhibits forward in good time. Where an animal is entered in more than one class, the committee accepts no responsibility should they clash.
15. The Association, Committee, assistants or stewards shall be in no way held responsible for any loss, damage, injury howsoever caused.
16. Any animal thought to be suffering from any infectious or contagious disease will be asked to leave the showground immediately by the committee.
17. No entry fee will be refunded unless a Veterinary Certificate is produced.
18. Dogs must be kept on the lead at all times.

- 19. All exhibitors must be conversant with the current rules set by the WPCS, P(UK), NPS & NECWPCA
- 20. Policy for closing rings:
IN HAND – *When the last pony/cob has done its individual trot round.*
RIDDEN - *When the class goes into trot*
