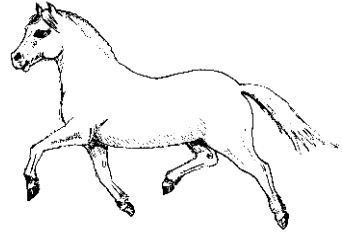

POLLYANNA HOME PRODUCED SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIP

These classes are open to horse and ponies that have been stabled at home since 1st August 2009. DIY livery is acceptable providing it is not the establishment of a professional show producer/trainer. Horses/ponies entering these championships must be owned, produced, ridden or led by the owner/spouse or his/her son/daughter/grandchild. It is expected that exhibitors will enter into the true spirit of this competition. The directors reserve the right in their absolute discretion, to refuse an exhibitors entry should they be in contravention of this rule in the directors considered opinion.

1st, 2nd and 3rd placed ponies/horses in all 2010 Summer Pollyanna Home Produced Qualifiers will qualify for the 2010 P(UK) Summer Championships.

Qualification cards will not be presented in the ring.

All riders/Handlers must apply to become either junior/senior riders club members within 14 days of qualifying in order for their qualification for the summer Pollyanna Championships to remain valid.

P(UK) POLLYANNA HOME PRODUCED YOUNG HANDLER SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIP

All handler classes are to be judged on the handler's presentation and showing technique.

Class 44 Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 153cms, to be led by a handler who has attained their 7th birthday but has not attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. ***1st, 2nd & 3rd placed horses/ponies will qualify. No qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, placings will be confirmed by results sent in by the show secretary.***

Class 45 Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 158cm, to be led by a handler who has attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. ***1st, 2nd & 3rd placed horses/ponies will qualify. No qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, placings will be confirmed by results sent in by the show secretary.***

P(UK) COLNE CONFINED NOVICE M & M LEAD REIN SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIP

Class 46 Open to Confined Novice Mountain & Moorland Leading Rein Ponies not to have won a first prize of £10.00 or more in any open M&M Leading Rein class before 1st January in the current year. Open to Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Welsh A & B ponies, registered in their respective Pure Bred Societies. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Lead Rein to be attached to the noseband only. ***1st, 2nd & 3rd placed horses/ponies will qualify. No qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, placings will be confirmed by results sent in by the show secretary.***

P(UK) LOBSTER POT M & M LEAD REIN SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIP

Class 47 Mountain & Moorland Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Registered in their respective Pure Bred Society Stud Books of Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest and Welsh A or B. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a Snaffle Bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only. ***1st, 2nd & 3rd placed horses/ponies will qualify. No qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, placings will be confirmed by results sent in by the show secretary.***

P(UK) BRINETON CONFINED NOVICE M&M FIRST RIDDEN SUMMER
CHAMPIONSHIP

Class 48 Open to Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A & B, registered in their respective Pure Bred Societies and not to have won a first prize of £10.00 or more in any open M&M first ridden class. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128 cms. To be shown in any suitable bridle. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Qualification must ONLY be given in a Confined Novice M&M First Ridden class and not within an Open M&M First Ridden class. ***1st, 2nd & 3rd placed horses/ponies will qualify.*** ***No qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, placings will be confirmed by results sent in by the show secretary.***

P(UK) BRINETON M&M FIRST RIDDEN SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIP

Class 49 Open to Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A & B, registered in their respective Pure Bred Societies. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128 cms. To be shown in any suitable bridle. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Qualification must ONLY be given in a M&M First Ridden class – not within a Riding Pony First Ridden class. ***1st, 2nd & 3rd placed horses/ponies will qualify.*** ***No qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, placings will be confirmed by results sent in by the show secretary.***

Class 50 (M&M Small Breeds) Open to Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A & B, registered in their respective Pure Bred Societies. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128 cms. Rider not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 51 (M&M Large Breeds) Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C & D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider not to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year

Class 52 (Intermediate M&M) Open to Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over registered in their approved Pure Breed Society's stud books of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C or D. Rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year. (See Rule 7 of the current P(UK) rule book)

Class 54 Open to Confined Novice Mountain & Moorland Ponies registered in their respective Pure Bred Society Stud Books of Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C & D. Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years old and over not to have won a first prize of £10.00 or more in any open ridden M&M class at any show on or before 21st January in the current year. Rider any age. (Please see rule 7, page 5, in the 2006 Rule Book.)

**DIRECTIONS TO RICHMOND EQUESTRIAN CENTRE
FROM THE SOUTH:**

On the A1 heading north take the A6136 for Catterick & Richmond. At the top of the slip road there is a brown tourist sign RICHMOND EQUESTRIAN CENTRE 2 ¼ miles. Follow subsequent signs as directed.

FROM THE NORTH:

On the A1 heading south take the first turn off past Scotch Corner (A6136) signposted Catterick. Continue on this road past Catterick race course and into Catterick Village. In the village turn right where there is a brown tourist sign RICHMOND EQUESTRIAN CENTRE, follow subsequent signs as directed.

Rules & Regulations

1. All animals to be registered in the appropriate studbook. All registration numbers must be stated on the entry form.
2. The committee reserve the right to refuse any entry.
3. The committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any class(es).
4. On no account is any animal to be exhibited under a judge who is known to have bred, leased, sold or produced that animal.
5. All Colts and Stallions over 2 years old must be licensed with the appropriate breed society, correctly bitted with a snaffle type bridle and led by a handler who has attained their 14th before the 1st of January in the current year.
6. All trophies remain the property of the NECWPCA and winners are responsible for their safe return.
7. The judges decision is FINAL
8. Anyone conducting themselves in a disorderly manner will be asked to leave the Showground.
9. Exhibitors must ensure all animals are sound. If in the opinion of the judge any animal is considered unsound, the exhibitor may withdraw the exhibit from the class or ask for a vet to examine the animal, if no vet is available the judge's decision is final. (all vets fees paid by exhibitor)
10. Objections must be lodged in writing to the Secretary within thirty minutes of the disputed event. A deposit of £30 must be paid, which will be returned if the objection is upheld. The decision of the committee is FINAL.
11. The committee will deal with all disputes relating to the Association and their decision is final and binding without any appeal to law.
12. It is recommended that all exhibitors have PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE.
13. Correctly secured skull caps / riding hats to be worn by riders at all times when mounted and by children whilst in the ring.
14. Exhibitors are reminded that all times are approximated, please have all exhibits forward in good time. Where an animal is entered in more than one class, the committee accepts no responsibility should they clash.
15. The Association, Committee, assistants or stewards shall be in no way held responsible for any loss, damage, injury howsoever caused.
16. Any animal thought to be suffering from any infectious or contagious disease will be asked to leave the showground immediately by the committee.
17. No entry fee will be refunded unless a Veterinary Certificate is produced.
18. Dogs must be kept on the lead at all times.
19. All exhibitors must be conversant with the current rules set by the WPCS, P(UK) & NECWPCA

Policy for closing rings:

IN HAND – *When the last pony/cob has done its individual trot round.*

RIDDEN - *When the class goes into trot*
